This young man used to be followed with Dr. Nadia Sakati in the Genetic clinic as well as Dr. Michael Nester in the neuroscience clinic, with last follow up in 2010.

The below summary is a medical evaluation that was done by Dr. Michael Nester during the last clinical assessment.

#### PRESENTING PROBLEM

This is a young man of 15 years old whom I have seen previously a number of times and I would refer to my early reports for full background. The most recent was in June 2009. Essentially, Mohammed is a boy with Fragile X syndrome with normal cognitive abilities but very significant attention deficit disorder and learning disability. This is an update.

#### FINDINGS

Mohammed is much as before. He remains in the Multinational School in the 8th grade. Reading and writing skills are around 4th grade level to 5th grade level at this point with math a good bit lower. Mohammed uses a calculator at school. He remains significantly inattentive and distractible with some impulsivity as well. He continues to make many careless errors particularly in mathematics. This is quite common in children with attention problems. Socially, Mohammed remains significantly immature.

#### IMPRESSION

As before, Mohammed is a young man with normal cognitive abilities, moderate to severe attention deficit hyperactive disorder of the combined type, social immaturity and learning disability. Academics are around 4th grade level for the most part with math a bit lower.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

We have counselled the family at some length. Mohammed needs to continue in a specialized program such as the Multinational School as he simply cannot cope with a regular program. He requires a great deal of one-on-one and group support by teachers who are particularly skilled in working with learning disabled children. The picture is somewhat complicated by attention disorder and social immaturity. Mohammed really needs a specialized center with the comprehensive approach to such children that is required. Mohammed has done quite well to reach his current levels and we would ask that this be continued.
